### DEWS 2011 SPEED SERIES REGISTRATION FORM

1. Defined below are the regulations or the DEWS 2011 Speed Series run by the DEWS Club.
2. You must be a registered member of the DEWS Club to enter.
3. The cost to enter the series is **£15.00p**.
4. Any MSA hillclimb or sprint that you enter can count towards the Speed Series with the best 5 scores to count.
5. Results must be sent to the competition secretary within one month of the event taking place. Final results must be submitted by 1<sup>st</sup> November 2011.
6. I expect there are many of you who have been to a hillclimb or sprint and wanted to enter, but felt that you did not have a suitable car or that the total costs were prohibitive. You will need to check the MSA Blue Book under Sprints, Hill Climbs and Drag Racing for Competitors' Regulations and any supplementary regulations from the club who is organising the event you are entering, but in very simple terms all you need are the following as minimum for road going cars, with modified cars requiring addition items as defined in the MSA 2011 Year Book:
  - a. A timing strut added on arrival at the event to the front of the car. This can be achieved easily without any damage to the car, see MSA 2011 Year book section 'S' para 10.9;
  - b. Ignition switch label, added by the ignition switch to show the direction to turn the key to "off".
  - c. **MSA** Speed Licence which allows you to compete in speed hillclimbs. This can be obtained by telephoning the MSA at Motor Sports House on 01753-765000 and asking for a competitor's licence application form to be sent to you. A non-race National B licence is £37 per year for events of national B status. This will, in addition, give you a copy of the MSA Competitors Year book, which includes all regulations for all types of events.  
**YOU DO NOT NEED A MEDICAL WITH YOUR DOCTOR FOR A SPEED LICENCE.**
  - d. A helmet to the correct specification. These can be obtained from many sources from about £109 upwards. See MSA 2011 Year book section 'K' para 10.1 to para 10.4
  - e. A pair of overalls to the correct specification. These can be obtained from many sources from about £70 upwards. See MSA 2011 Year book section 'K' para 9.1 to 9.3
  - f. A pair of gloves to ISO6490 specification. These can be obtained from many sources from about £40. See MSA 2011 Year book section 'K' para 14.3(e).
  - g. Competition numbers for your car, See MSA 2011 Year book section 'J' para 4.1 to 4.1.8
  - h. Battery earth lead marked with yellow tape, see MSA 2011 Year book section 'J' para 5.14.5
  - i. I would suggest that when you are purchasing your helmet, and overalls, that you take with you the current MSA year book and check the specification and label as defined in the MSA 2011 Year Book is attached before you make your purchase.
  - j. All loose or not required items must be removed from the car on safety grounds, in case they come loose and fly around such as:  
Spare wheel, jack, tool kit, plus everything else that is not fixed down e.g. things in the glove, door pockets etc.
  - k. **PLEASE NOTE: IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO MAKE SURE YOU & YOUR CAR COMPLY WITH THE MSA CURRENT COMPETITORS REGULATIONS.**
7. **If you are in any doubt, please ask, we are here to help you.**

## The classes for the DEWS Speed Series are as follows:

### Classes for road going 'A' Series Engine

1. Classic mini up to 1100cc
2. Classic mini up to 1400cc

### Class for road going – engine type free

3. Classic mini unlimited modification

### Classes for non road going mini's

4. Modified 8 valve up to 1400cc 'A' series based engine
5. Modified 16 valve up to 1400cc 'A' series based engine
6. Unlimited for mini resemblance engine type free

### Other classes

7. Modified 'A' series engine class front & rear wheel drive unrestricted - Road Legal
8. Modified 'A' series engine class front & rear wheel drive unrestricted
9. Invitation class for DEWS members whose cars fall outside other classes
10. Downton related vehicles 1947-1976

## Scoring as follows:

The number of points you score depends on where you finish in the class you have entered at the event, it does not matter whether the competitors who were faster than you had registered for the DEWS Speed Series or not.

One entry in class entered at event	Score	10 points
Two entries in class entered at event	Score 1 <sup>st</sup>	12 points
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	10 points
Three or more entries in class entered at event	Score 1 <sup>st</sup>	15 points
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	12 points
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	10 points
	Down to 12 <sup>th</sup>	1 point

If you have entered a DEWS Class at an event you will receive an extra 3 points on your score.

As our members are across the United Kingdom we will include any events in which you have participated and your 5 best scores will count.

All I ask it that you send/e-mail me a copy of your results page within 4 weeks of the event.

Also please check the calendar on the DEWS website [www.dewsc.org.uk](http://www.dewsc.org.uk) . If the clubs listed on our calendar have sent a copy of their regs for events, they will be attached under the relevant date and organising club or a link to the clubs own website. If you do not have the facility to print off or access the internet then I can print and post you a copy. Any other events you will need to contact the competition secretary for a set of regs.
